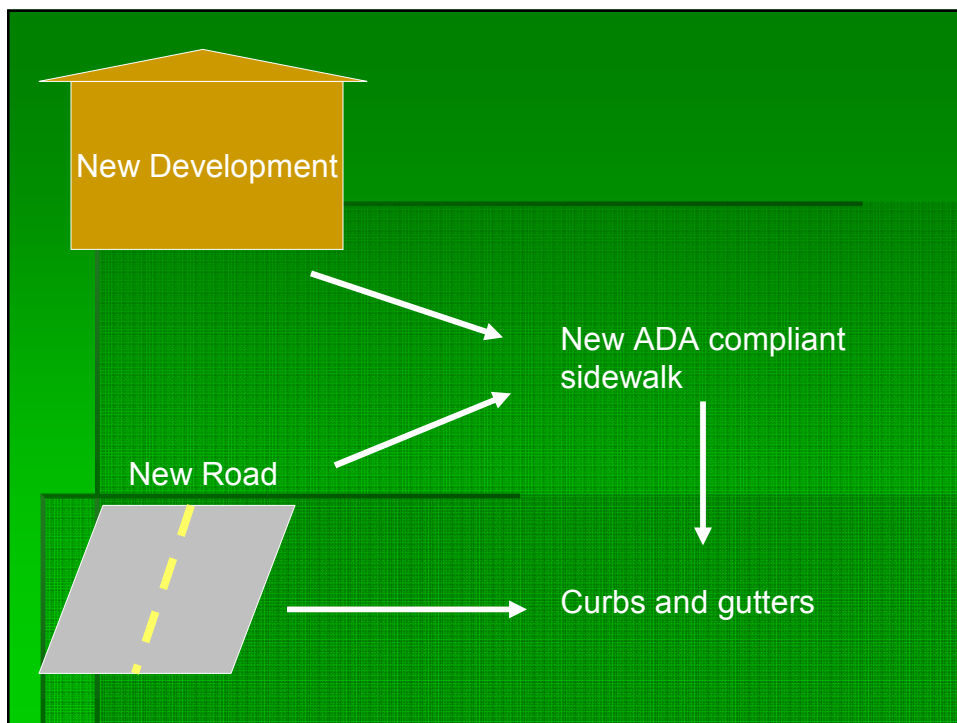


How do curbs and gutters get built?

- When a new street is constructed
- If a new sidewalk is constructed, curbs and gutters usually go in at the same time

How does a sidewalk get built?

- If a new development is built
- If a new street is constructed

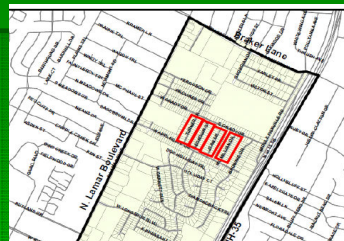


Sidewalk prioritization

- Sidewalk construction is prioritized based on:
 - Bus stops
 - Schools
 - Roadway type (residential, collector, arterial)
 - Many other factors
- Again – curbs and gutters usually go in with sidewalks

Sidewalk prioritization

- Interior, residential areas will typically have much lower priority
- Arterial roads like North Lamar have a very high priority



What can the neighborhood do?

- Let it be known where new sidewalks are needed...
 - 311
 - NA request for sidewalks
 - Request through adopted Neighborhood Plan
- Doing all of the above “bumps” up the prioritization
